- Sunday, May 18: 2:00 p.m. 6:00 p.m.
- Monday, May 19: 9:00 a.m. 6:00 p.m.
- Tuesday, May 20: 7:30 a.m. 6:00 p.m.

When claiming your credentials at registration, carry a picture ID and have it available at all times. A US\$25 replacement fee applies for misplaced badges (re-issued upon presentation of a picture ID). Badges are required for access to the Opening and Closing Celebrations.

Misuse of Delegate badges is prohibited. This includes sharing, rotating, or exchanging badges, and registering a delegate that represents a non-qualifying CHTA member, or an expired member. Violations will result in removal from the Caribbean Travel Marketplace Business Floor with no refund.

We urge all delegates to claim their registration materials and for suppliers/sponsors to set up their stations before the business sessions start on Tuesday morning.

Selling Floor

Suppliers and sponsor delegates can set up their displays and find their station allocation starting on Sunday, May 18 from 2:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. and continue on Monday, May 19 from 9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. Setup will only be allowed during registration hours. You will receive your station/display number when you pick up your registration credentials.
